

Introduction



Now we have begun to see Jesus in our Ordinals we will go deeper and learn just how great he is in the Word and God. Remember our numbers from previous lesson: **373**rd mention of **Jesus** - **65465**th **Word** in the Bible, and the Greek std Ordinal for '**Word**' which is **373**

In the following Ordinal Numerology we will see beyond all doubt that **Jesus** is **God** and the **Word**, and is verified by **God** as his **Son** (only begotten).

PURIFIED 7 TIMES

Psalms 12:6 Psalms 119:164

Jesus in Prime numbers

The **37,654**th Prime number = 5388893

'**Jesus**' in Greek std Ordinal = 888

'**Jesus**' in English std Ordinal = 515

The difference of the two is: $(888 - 515) = 373$

DEUTERONOMY contained the scriptures used by **Jesus** to fight Satan's hour of temptation.

The **37**th mention of '**Word**' in the KJ Bible

is the **688**th word of DEUTERONOMY.

The Greek std Ordinal for '**Jesus**' = 688

Lets pop back to Genesis and use ALL its Ordinal values for Hebrew and English.

GENESIS 1:1		SUM
HEBREW STANDARD	= 2701	GENE
ENGLISH STANDARD	= 2094	
HEBREW ORDINAL	= 298	68
ENGLISH ORDINAL	= 411	
TOTAL SUM	= 5504	688
2701+2094+298+411		888

As above image shows all the Genesis 1:1 Ordinals for Hebrew & English total up to **5504** which = (688×8) .

688 is the Greek Ordinal for '**Jesus**' (spelt without the sigma)

888 is the Greek Ordinal for 'Jesus' (spelt with the sigma)



In Greek 'Jesus' can be spelt in two ways, but God has it covered, the numbers STILL work. Now we will look at an incredible pattern shown in the prime numbers.

Look at Psalms 12:6

*The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth,
purified seven times.*



Keep that verse in mind as we go back into Genesis Ordinals.
Purified 7 times.....

GENESIS 1:1 ORDINAL
298+411 = 709
HEBREW+ENGLISH SUM = 709
The words of the LORD
are pure words: as silver
tried in a furnace of earth,
purified seven times.
PSALM 12:6 KJB

Genesis1:1 Ordinals for Hebrew & English (not adding the std Ordinals) = (298 + 411) = 709

Greek + Hebrew + English ordinals for 'Word' total to 148



The 148th Prime number is 857. Now deduct 148 to get 709. Whats the 709 all about you ask.. Watch closely.

The Prime Pattern

See the pattern shown above?

- 1.....The first prime = **2** so next is **2nd** prime number
- 2.....The **2nd** prime = **3** so next is **3rd** prime number
- 3.....The **3rd** prime = **5** so next is **5th** prime number
- 4.....The **5th** prime = **11** so next is **11th** prime
- 5.....The **11th** prime = **31** so next is **31st** prime
- 6.....The **31st** prime = **127** so last and **7th** prime is the **127th** prime
- 7.....The **127th** prime = **709**

Add them all up: 2+3+5+11+31+127+709 = 888

'Jesus' in Greek std Ordinal = 888

1 to 7 (7 Times).

Psalms 12:6

*The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth,
purified **seven** times.*

$$888 = (37 \times 24)$$

Genesis 2:4 contains the first mention of **'Lord'** in the KJ Bible

GENESIS 2:4
HEBREW STANDARD

יהוה אלהים עשות

the LORD God made...

26 86 776

26+86+776 = 888

FIRST MENTION OF the LORD {יהוה} IN THE SCRIPTURES

Genesis 2:4:

*These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the **LORD God made** the earth and the heavens,*

(1st mention of **'Lord'** in the scriptures)

Hebrew Ordinals: Lord = 26, God = 86, Made = 776

$$26 + 86 + 776 = 888$$



so remember how the ordinals for 'Lord God Made' = 888

the next word after that, which is 'the' (Lord God Made **the**) is the 888th word of the KJ Bible.

'Lord' is also the 88th word of Genesis chapter 2

Can you find a book more numerically pure than the KJ Bible,, Yes,, it will be Gods next book..!!
